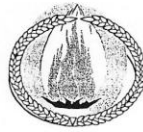

The Secretary General of the Central Committee, Chairperson of the Central Supervisory Committee for the Operations to renew the Executives of CPDM Basic Organs and its Specialised Organisations hereby communicates:

The Central Supervisory Committee for the Operations to renew the Executives of CPDM Basic Organs and its Specialised Organisations, meeting at the Party Headquarters on Wednesday, 27 October 2021, took stock of the conduct of electoral process within and outside the country. Arouse by the operations and their smooth conduct within and outside the country, despite some isolated but reprehensible outbursts, which in fact stemmed from the key value and importance of the Executives of the Basic Organs.

The Central Supervisory Committee has taken note of the results of the various elections for the Executives of Cells, Branches, Sub-Sections and Sections. In the same token, the Secretary General of the Central Committee invites the Heads of all Regional and Divisional Permanent Delegations of the Central Committee as well as the Presidents of the CPDM Sections to ensure that the elected Executives of the Sub-sections, Branches and Cells comply with the set rules and regulations.



The Secretary General of the Central Committee, Chairperson of the Central Supervisory Committee, conveys the thanks of the National President to the members of the various Committees who conducted the electoral process in the field, as well as his warm congratulations to the militants for their high sense of responsibility throughout the process. He further expresses his warm encouragement to the newly-elected officials

who will be leading the Party for the next five years in their respective jurisdictions.

Continuing in the same line as the National President, the Secretary General of the Central Committee requests the newly-elected officials, especially the Presidents of the CPDM Section Executives, to immediately get down to work in a spirit of unity and cohesion, in order to dispel the misunderstandings that arose during the elections and to rebuild the indispensable synergy of action around the ideals of the Party, in view of the future elections. To this end, they must count on the fair play of candidates who did not benefit from the votes of their comrades, by reassuring them of their total and constant belonging to the great CPDM family.

On the occasion of the **39th anniversary of the accession of His Excellency Paul BIYA to the Supreme Magistracy** on 6 November 2021, the Secretary General of the Central Committee calls on all CPDM, WCPDM and YCPDM Section Presidents to an unitary commemoration which shall be a moment of mobilisation and gathering of CPDM militants, friends and sympathisers.


